REGULAR MEETING MINUTES August 10th, 2021

DISTRICT CHAIR, RICK LOGGINS, called the meeting to order at 1:31 p.m.

ROLL CALL (a quorum was present) was as follows:

CONSENT CALENDAR: Regular Meeting Minutes

Minutes from the last meeting (April 13, 2021) were read. We had a motion from Michael McNeil (STPAO) to accept the minutes and a second from Mike Thiel (FD #1) to accept.

REGULAR AGENDA:

- 1) Rick Loggins (Parish) introduced two new Parish GIS staff members; Catherine Robinson (GIS Specialist) and Christine Evans (GIS Technician) as well as our new Director of Technology, Grant Black.
- 2) Chad Whaley (Mandeville) could not attend the meeting, but sent notice that he had submitted forms to become the representative on the GIS District representing the St Tammany Parish Municipal Association. He was told that it would be voted on at the October Meeting of the STPMA.
- 3) Mike Thiel received notice that he had been appointed to represent the St Tammany Parish Fire Chiefs on the GIS District.

- 4) The Chair received a letter appointing Michael McNeil to represent the assessor's Office on the GIS District. The members welcomed Michael McNeil.
- 5) Rick Loggins (Parish) noted that he will be retiring from service with the Parish as of September 30, 2021. He gave a brief history of the creation of the GIS District. He recommended that future Chairs rotate among the five members to give everyone a chance to contribute.
- 6) Robert Crawford (FD #4) noted that there were still some issues to work out in order to share data between the EOC and other Public Safety Organizations, a plug in to integrate ESRI's data into WebEOC is one example. He was able to setup and test Geo Event Server to use to track vehicles and personnel during an event.
- 7) Current participants in the ESRI Enterprise Agreement were asked if they were interested in renewing in 2023? All current participants responded affirmatively

COMMENTS AND REPORTS:

Chair Rick Loggins asked each member to describe any GIS Projects that they were working on that other members might be interested in.

- 1) Robert Crawford (FD #4) noted that he is working on a Parish flood model with the Flood Inundation Center. He also mentioned that he is helping FD #13 setup an ESRI Enterprise Deployment.
- 2) Mike Thiel (FD #1) noted that there is still a lot of work to do to ensure that First Responder data is integrated into WebEOC.
- 3) Mark Dalyrmple (Covington) noted that recently he has been receiving Public Record Requests, but Covington has no policy or procedures for responding to these requests. He noted that Craig Johnson (Parish) shared the forms the Parish uses.
- 4) Michael McNeil (STPAO) noted that the Assessors Office is working on a new Assessment System with the Clerk of Court and they hope to go live in the Fall.
- 5) All of the participants in the meeting wished Rick Loggins congratulations and good wishes on his upcoming retirement.

Motion to Adjourn was made at 3:05 by Mike Thiel and seconded by Rick Loggins. All were in favor.
