REGULAR AGENDA:

Unfinished Business:

1) **ESRI Enterprise Agreement Renewal Discussion** Traci Tracey and Zena Pelletier were present for the meeting. Traci provided a presentation on the Negotiated Enterprise Agreement. This presentation showed all ESRI software items used by the GIS District based on the organization's usage reports. The GIS District is using \$283,000 (per year) of software and paying \$140,000/ year as per the current contracted price. Traci met with the ESRI corporate accountants to help find ways

to lower the cost of the next EA. They switched some of the Advanced Desktops to Standards and deleted some desktop extensions that were never used.

The AGO Subscription types were also increased to support the Districts growing needs to:

300 Viewers, 75 Editors, 325 Mobile Workers, 100 Creator User Type.

Additional "Capped Licenses" were added to the EA:

ArcGIS Community Analyst Web App Online – 5 Term Licenses

ArcGIS Insights in ArcGIS Online - 5 Term Licenses

ArcGIS Drone2Map for AGOL- 1 Term License

The Proposed Renewal EA Fee from ESRI is as follows:

Year 1 - \$155,000

Year 2 - \$175,000

Year 3 - \$200,000

Total - \$530,000

Traci stated that it doesn't matter how the payment is broken up each year, as long as by Year 3, ESRI receives a full payment of \$530,000 for all 3 years.

ESRI has not taken anything away or anything out of the current EA. Everyone will still have access to what they are currently using.

- 2) **Enterprise Agreement Participants** The Assessor's Office has decided to stay independent and not join the EA with the rest of the GIS District.
- 3) Waze/ Google Maps used for Road Closures, high water, debris in roadway. –
 Robert stated that the Google Maps road closures have started showing up on Waze.
 STP Public Works can report road closures in Field Maps that will be updated to
 Google Maps and Waze once STP starts using the Damage Assessment tool.
- 4) **Municipal Boundaries –** GIS District to all use the same municipal boundaries Will revisit in future meetings.

New Business:

- 5) **Voting th STPAO in the EA** No longer necessary due to STPAO deciding to stay independent.
- 6) **Sharing Agreement** Standardize an inter-agency data sharing agreement based on all parities needs All organizations in the GIS District will sign this one sharing agreement document. Will revisit in future meetings.
- 7) **LaURISA Mappy Hour** September 22, 2022, 5:30-7:30pm at Barley Oak, Mandeville Lakefront.

COMMENTS AND REPORTS:

Kevin Caillout (Director of STMAD) spoke about getting high resolution Lidar data to see where water pools to locate and eliminate a specific bread of water hyacinth plant that breeds mosquitos.
